- Congratulations to the following youth shooters who were named to the Wisconsin State Trap Shooting Team for 2019: Cody Barwick, Jacob Wendorf, Jacob Corallo, Kendra Doberstein and Sage McKeough. In order to qualify for the team, these youth needed to shoot a minimum of 1,500 singles targets, 1,000 handicap targets, and 800 doubles targets at ATA registered shoots; compete at the Wisconsin State shoot; participate in a Wisconsin Zone shoot; and shoot at 4 different clubs throughout the year. They represented our club well at all the shoots.
- The shooting rules were reviewed at the last meeting. No pricing changes are being implemented this year. We will begin throwing orange targets once the pink targets are depleted. We will suspend the Team Championship Shoot for the upcoming year and will replace it with a Club Championship shoot instead. The top team from each division will shoot off during the week following submission of final scores and will compete for the title of Club Champion.
- We will again be holding the Spring Banquet on April 2nd. As in previous years, we are soliciting donations from members to use as prizes. Anything you wish to donate would be appreciated and may be left at the club or given to a Board Member. Services, retail merchandise, and beverages are just a few ideas of items that have been used in the past.

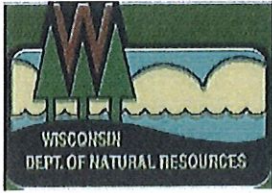
