

Good morning, Weston Trap Club members, I hope everyone is doing well!!

**This is just a quick note to let you know that the trap club will not be open tomorrow (Easter Sunday) for open shooting. We would like everyone to be able to enjoy this day with their family. Open shooting will resume on Wednesday evening at 6:00 pm.**

As our 2022 season gets started, here are a few highlights from the captain's meeting for those of you who were not able to attend:

The club members have voted again to allow members to shoot their league rounds whenever it is convenient for them. This will be similar to last year. This decision was made mostly based on the availability of shells. Just a reminder that the club does have shells for sale for those members who have not been able to secure any at this time. The cost is \$11.00/box.

Many of the teams have already signed up for their work weeks. Those teams who have not signed up will be randomly drawn this week and assigned to the remaining open weeks. In addition, we do have many open spots for an overseer each week. If anyone is able to help with that it would be greatly appreciated.

As a reminder, the club will not have setters this year. This decision was made based on the cost of the workman's comp insurance. Filling houses and filling targets are some of the duties that have been added to the weekly team work schedule. The work list is posted behind the bar for everyone to see.
